

Mentorship

TMP2022 lasted for a minimum of eight (8) weeks, started in September with selection and onboarding of mentors and mentees, 2022 and ended in November with the demo-ing of final projects and graduation of mentees (finalists). The programme was a success, as we recorded significant development and progress as compared to the previous edition (maiden edition). We had mentees and mentors from across the globe (Nigeria, Ghana, India etc).

We used a very special platform Mently to manage the Techrity Mentorship programme; from scheduling of mentor-mentees bi-weekly sessions, team meetings, to monitoring the progress of the mentors, likewise, the mentees and also awarding badges to outstanding mentors.

This year we had to step it up further by sourcing out internship opportunities for some of our mentees, so as to further develop their core strength in their respective area of technology.
